



The Grading Scale at ESSEC Global BBA

On the Global BBA programme, we use a grading scale from 1 – 20, with 20 being the highest possible grade, and 10 the minimum acceptable pass grade in each subject. A grade of 20 is extremely rare, so grades of 16 and above are considered to be excellent.

Our grades relate to the European ECTS grading scale as follows:

GRADE	BBA GRADE	DEFINITION
A	16-20	EXCELLENT : Outstanding performance
B	14-15	VERY GOOD : above the average standard but with some errors
C	12-13	GOOD : generally sound work with a number of notable errors
D	11	SATISFACTORY : fair but with significant shortcomings
E	10	SUFFICIENT: performances meets the minimum criteria
F	0-9	FAIL : considerable further work is required

Only those students with a passing grade of 10/20 or above receive ECTS credit for the course on the Global BBA, and those who do not fail the class.

Double degree students: The Global BBA requires Double Degree students to validate 60 ECTS for the year, with on average 30 ECTS per semester.

Semester or full-year exchange students: If the student received a grade less than 10 for a class, then the ECTS credits are not awarded for the course according to ESSEC Global BBA regulations, however each university converts the grades according to its own criteria.

No re-sits or make-up exams are available to students.
